

Due to the high water level of the Gasconade River this week (06/01/15 thru 06/05/15) we were unable to sample and test for E.coli and Ammonia; water levels are too dangerous for the staff and I to be on the river . We will sample again next Wednesday (6-10-15). We are scheduled to have a DNR Environmental Specialist from the Water Quality Monitoring Unit (Randy Niemeyer) and the Pulaski County Health Department (Israel Doba) present next week while collecting samples. I will be sending results out no later than Friday (6-12-15) at noon. If you know anyone that would like to be present at any time we are sampling or testing have them contact me by phone or email. We will be sampling every Wednesday from now until the end of October. The E.coli testing will be performed as soon as we get back to our lab the day of sampling and read the following day. The Ammonia testing will be started the day of sampling as well and will be completed by the end of the following day. If you have any questions feel free to call and/or email me at any time.
